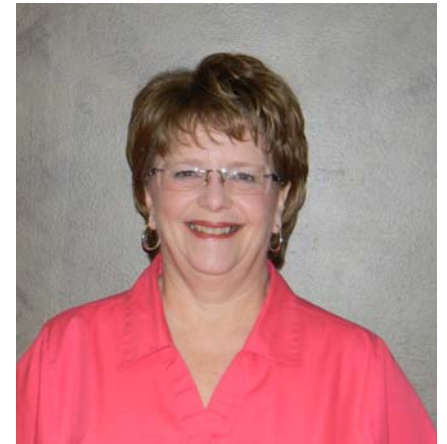
Wabash Adds New Employees
